The Social Worker is responsible for activities and interventions pertaining to patient care planning and delivery, including discharge planning, crisis intervention and palliative care coordination.

The Hospital has 23 acute care beds, 26 long-term care beds, a 24-hour emergency department, and a heliport. Services provided include clinical nutrition, diagnostic imaging (x-ray & ultrasound), laboratory, outreach chemotherapy, rehabilitation (PT & OT), social work and telemedicine.

The community of Greenstone is comprised of 5 small communities in northern Ontario, including Geraldton which is centrally located and has a population of approximately 1500 people. Geraldton is approximately 2.5 hours from Thunder Bay and easily assessable by car on the Trans-Canada Highway.
